

# GARY B & THE NOTIONS



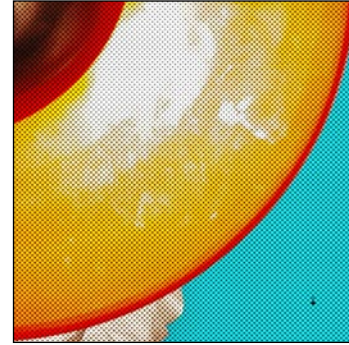
*New Twist & Shout*, the new record from **Gary B & the Notions**, will make you sing and make you smile, and may even make you dance a little.

As Baltimore's music scene blossomed over the past few years, he's had the fortune of performing with many wonderful touring acts such as Sufjan Stevens, the Hold Steady, Of Montreal, The Dismemberment Plan, Elf Power, and The Mountain Goats, as well as local artists like Beach House, Celebration, Deleted Scenes, Jukebox The Ghost, and Animal Collective.

On "Give Me One Reason", Gary B sings, "Ain't it funny how wrong we are sometimes, like the Earth shining on the Sun..." *New Twist & Shout* is far from wrong—it is so, so right for those warm summer days and warm summer nights, hanging with friends or cruising around town.
